Even amidst these troubling times, the NIPRO Group remains dedicated to increasing the competitiveness of its products and to furthering its global expansion based on the Sanpo-yoshi concept of "Good for Everyone" and the concept of "Local

production for local consumption." We also remain hopeful that our contributions to the medical treatment front line will help inspire an increased call for peace.

I would now like to take a moment to talk about the NIPRO Group's corporate creed of "Willingness." Willingness is the driving force behind every aspect of life; individuals who adopt a sense of willingness are rewarded with various opportunities, and those without willingness are left empty-handed.
