

Notice of Trade Name Change of Medical Device Subsidiary in the Republic of Korea

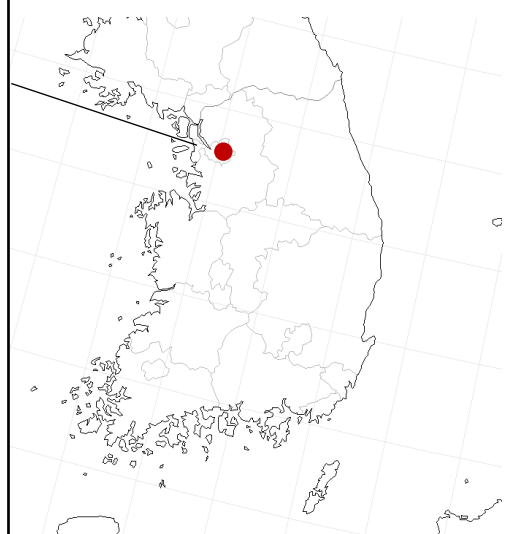
NIPRO CORPORATION is pleased to announce that one of its subsidiaries, Nipro Dongduk Medical Corporation (Head office: Seoul, Republic of Korea; hereinafter “Nipro Dongduk”), changed its trade name to NIPRO MEDICAL KOREA CORPORATION on March 26, 2025.

Since acquiring shares in 2015, NIPRO has been engaged in the sale of medical devices, including dialyzers and dialysis machines, in the Republic of Korea through Nipro Dongduk. With this trade name change, NIPRO aims to further enhance the presence of the NIPRO brand and expand its market share. In addition, to strengthen its competitiveness in the market by offering comprehensive dialysis-related products, NIPRO plans to newly obtain a pharmaceutical wholesale license and add pharmaceuticals such as dialysis solutions and cleaning agents to its product lineup.

Under this new trade name, the NIPRO Group will continue to provide community-based, attentive services while striving to meet the needs of the medical treatment front line while also further expanding the company’s business activities around the world.
