

Impact on the NIPRO Group from the Earthquake in Colombia

NIPRO CORPORATION (Head office: Settsu, Osaka; President and Representative Director: Tsuyoshi Yamazaki) extends its deepest condolences to those who lost their lives in the earthquake that struck western Colombia on August 10, 2026, and expresses its heartfelt sympathies to all those affected by the disaster and their families. NIPRO hereby announces the impact of the earthquake on the NIPRO Group based on the information confirmed as of this time, as follows.

1. Status of the NIPRO Group's Locations in Colombia

As of this time, no injuries or fatalities have been confirmed among employees working at these locations. In addition, no significant damage to the buildings or facilities that would materially affect business operations has been identified.

The NIPRO Group will continue to confirm the safety and circumstances of employees and their families residing in the affected areas and provide necessary support.

2. Impact on Business Operations and the Supply Chain

Following the earthquake, the NIPRO Group assessed the impact on its buildings, facilities, employees, and other relevant areas. As of this time, no significant impact on the stable supply of the Group's medical devices and other products has been identified.

The NIPRO Group will continue to assess the impact on its entire supply chain, including distributors and business partners. Should any matter requiring public disclosure be identified, the Group will promptly provide further information.
